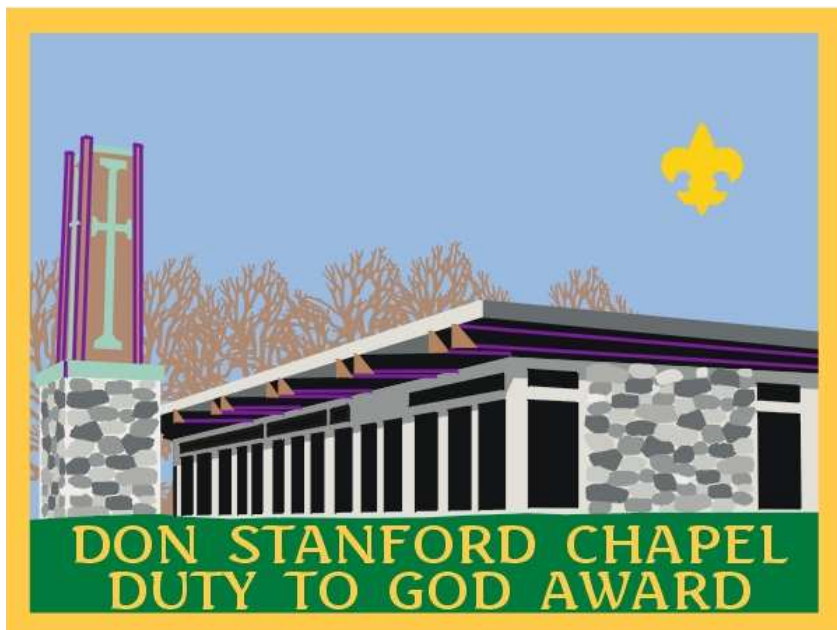
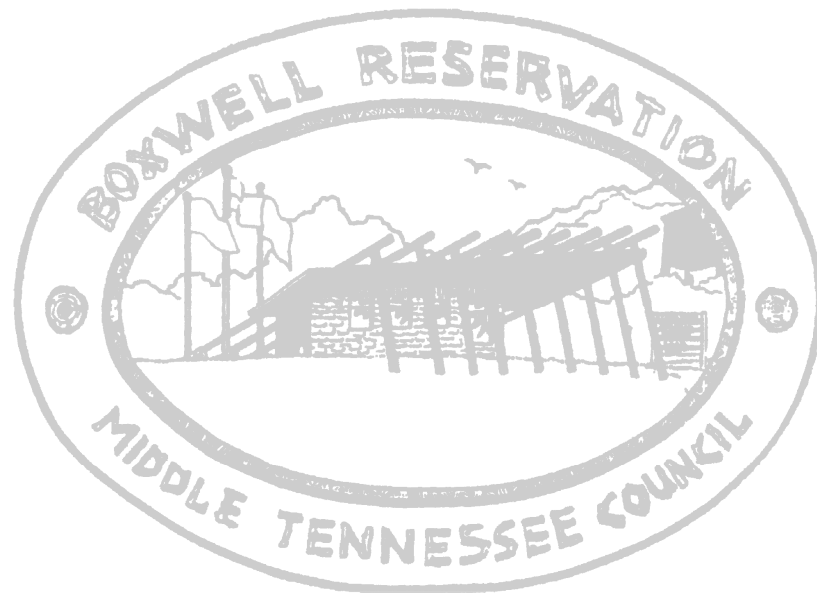

Boxwell Duty to God Program



DAY 1: MONDAY

Theme: Open Your Mind

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction. Proverbs 1:7

With your group, discuss the following:

- What does it mean to have an “open mind”?
- How can an “open mind” help you have a positive experience at Boxwell?

DAY 2: TUESDAY

Theme: Re-creation

Observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy, as the LORD your god has commanded you. Deuteronomy 5:12

With your group, discuss the following:

- Why is it important to rest?

DAY 3: WEDNESDAY

Theme: Be a Good Neighbor

You shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD. Leviticus 19:18b

With your group, discuss the following:

- How can you be sensitive to the needs of others?

DAY 4: THURSDAY

Theme: God is with You

The LORD is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid? Psalm 27:1

With your group, discuss the following:

- Why are you here? Name one or two goals for yourself.

DAY 5: FRIDAY

Theme: Remembering

I will remember my covenant between me and you and all living creatures. Genesis 9:15a

With your group, discuss the following:

- What memories from Boxwell do you want to take with you?
- What can you do to make sure you never forget these experiences?

While at Boxwell, you will encounter God’s handiwork on many occasions. The Boxwell **Duty to God** program will allow you to reflect on that and earn some recognition.

ELIGIBILITY

Scouts and adults are eligible to participate in the program.

PROGRAM

1. Participants must complete three requirements:
 - a. Attend Wednesday religious service while at Boxwell
 - b. Participate in at least one daily devotional with your Scout unit
 - c. Lead Grace before a meal
2. Participants must obtain a Chaplain’s Aide or Program Director’s signature or appointed staff member assigned at camp to certify completion of the requirements
3. Scouts and leaders may purchase a **Boxwell Duty to God** patch from the Trading Post or Cripple Crab.
