

2010 HAI Fund Camp Scholarship Nomination Form

DEADLINE: March 12, 2010

Greg and Minh-Triet of Readyville, TN have established a camp scholarship to encourage older, more experienced Boy Scouts to attend Summer Camp at Boxwell Reservation.

The scholarship has been established in memory of the late Hai Nguyenthi, mother of Minh-Triet. Hai Nguyenthi was noted for her philanthropic and charitable interest both in the United States and in her native Vietnam. She was a co-founder and patron of one of the larger orphanages in Saigon, and in her later years worked extensively with the Salvation Army in Sacramento, CA. She died on January 31, 1996, at her daughter's home in Readyville, TN at the age of 82.

The scholarship will pay the full camp fee, for Middle Tennessee Scouts. This Scholarship does not apply towards any other cost associated with the cost of camp. It is expected that the scholarship will not only benefit the individual recipients by encouraging continued participation in Scout camping and BSA High Adventure opportunities, but will also assist local Scout units by providing experienced, older Scouts as youth leaders while the unit is at Summer Camp.

The awards will be based on Scout merit. Any Scout leader can nominate one or several eligible Scouts. The minimum eligibility requirements are (1) nominees must be registered Scouts and at least 13 years old by January 1, 2010, and at least two prior seasons at Summer Camp; and (2) recipients must attend Summer Camp at Boxwell Reservation in a youth leadership capacity with their troop during the current season. (Scouts participating in off-reservation programs are not eligible).

Factors that will be considered in selecting recipients from among those nominated will include demonstrated leadership and team work skills. Scout advancement and awards earned, camping experience, character, and willingness to help others. The Council Camping Committee will select recipients from among those nominated.

Nominations for the 2010 Hai Fund Scholarships should be submitted by March 12, 2010. Forms should be mailed to the Camping Department, 3414 Hillsboro Rd, PO Box 150409, Nashville, TN 37215.
