What is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is an action-packed, exciting program designed to provide youth members of the Middle Tennessee Council, Boy Scouts of America, with leadership skills and experience that they can use in their home units and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

Participants learn and practice Goal Setting, Planning, Problem Solving, Decision Making, and Conflict Resolution through classes, games, and outdoor activities. Participants learn to use the Leading EDGE and the Teaching EDGE by working with their patrols in an exciting and challenging course environment.

Who May Attend?

A scout or venture must have the following qualifications by July 1, 2012:

Boy Scouts – *Must be a current member of BSA*Be 13 years of age and have completed the 7th grade *Be a First Class Scout

For Venture Scouts - *Must be 13 years of age and have completed the 7th grade *Must have completed the ILSC training prior to this training.

Exceptions will not be made for the age or rank requirements. Each Participant must bring a completed Health & Medical Record form (signed by a doctor) in order to participate in the course.

Details

- Participants should plan to arrive at Boxwell at 11:30 A.M. on Sunday, July 17th. They will be ready to depart at 8:30 P.M. on Friday, July 20.
- The cost is \$180.00 for the week.
- Those who are recommended by their Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor as meeting the above requirements should send a **\$80.00 deposit and a completed, signed application** to the Council office as soon as possible. Enrollment will be limited to 48 participants (eight patrols) on a first-come-first-served basis so apply early! By mid-July, all participants will receive a letter with a list of items to bring and other details.

REMEMBER: Participants must stay through the entire course so CHECK YOUR SCHEDULES CAREFULLY!
