This 17-hr. course teaches the knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to organizing, promoting, and teaching the NRA's *Basic Shotgun Shooting Course*.

The NRA Instructor Training Courses help you develop the additional knowledge, skills and techniques needed to organize and teach Basic Shooting Courses in the NRA Basic Firearm Training Program.

Prerequisite: Possession of basic firearm safety and shooting skills is a prerequisite for certification as a NRA Shotgun Instructor.

"Must verify a Basic Shooting Course Certificate upon time of registration."

Prior to the Instructor training, candidates must fill out a pre-course questionnaire and demonstrate their firearm background in a pre-course assessment and exercises.

The Shotgun Instructor Course is presented in two parts. Basic Instructor Training and Discipline Specific Instructor Training.

Students demonstrate organizational and teaching skills via participation in practical exercises during the course and complete an instructor certification examination.

Candidates will receive the NRA Trainers Guide, NRA Shotgun Shooting Instructor Candidate Packet, and must have NRA Basic Student Handbook.
