During several of the 13 years coaching Jaycee youth basketball, Ray coached not just one but two or three teams a season depending on what was needed. In all those years, he never received a technical foul which is something that can't be said about many of the coaches. He was always patient with the boys he coached and modeled for them that a competitive spirit can include respect of others both on and off of the court. He also modeled hospitality in all of these youth activities including Scouting by opening his home to meetings even to an annual 4-H state council meeting where both chaperones and 4-H members met in his home for the weekend. As can be seen from the years of service in each of the activities listed above, when he agreed to help with a youth organization whether it was as a Bible study children's leader, a coach or a volunteer, he was committed to the activity until someone else was in place to replace him modeling for all the youth he encountered what it means to be loyal and committed to an organization. He is an Eagle Scout who continues to live the Scout Law in all his endeavors both professionally and with any youth he encountered along the way.
